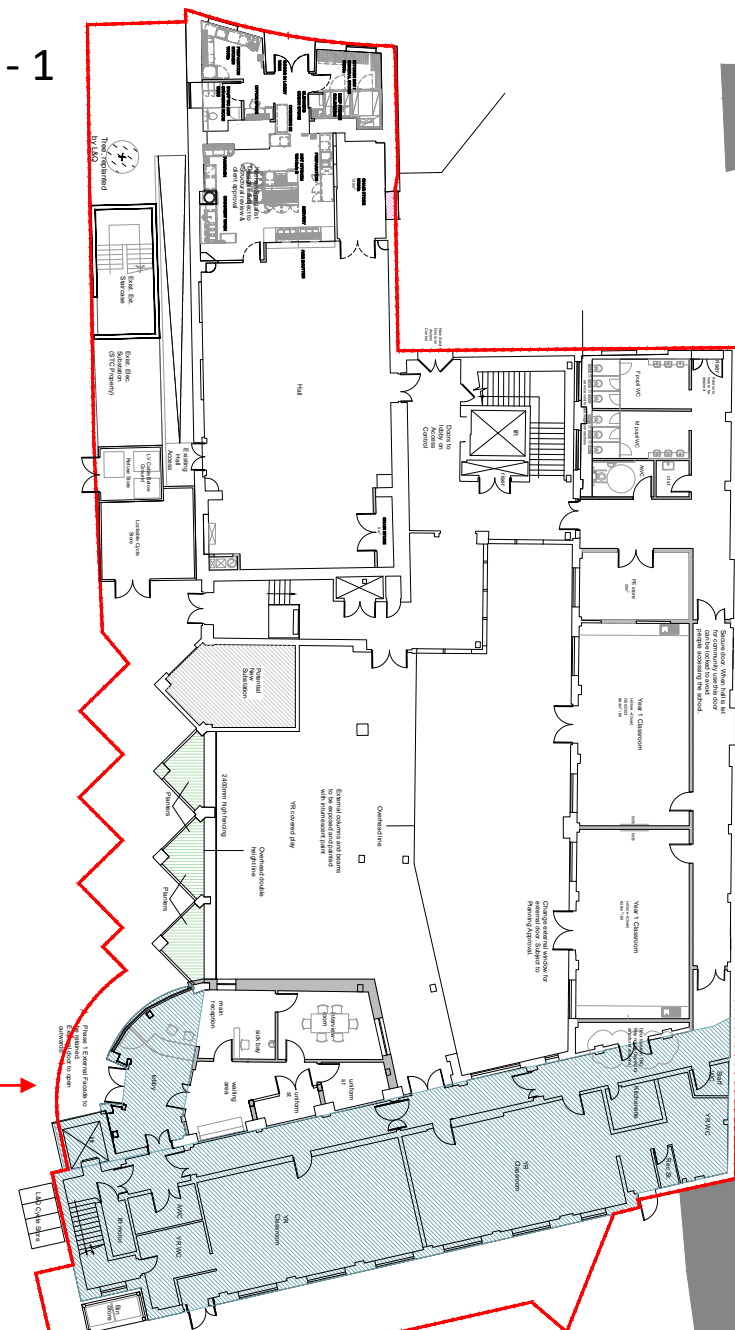
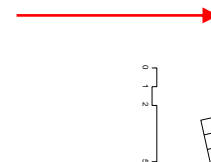


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General overview of the building footprint - 1

The interior partition works to divide the school from South Thames College took place before September 2022. The school and the college are two separate entities and have no access to each other's properties through the inside of the building.

This is the external façade of the school building





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There will be **3 Play decks and a covered Reception outdoor area** open to the courtyard (internal view) for all year-round use.

The playdecks will be designed to match children's developmental needs

Ground floor: Reception outdoor area & covered outdoor play

First floor: Year 1 & Year 2 playdeck

Second floor: Year 3 & Year 4 playdeck

Third floor: Year 5 & Year 6 playdeck

Children will be able to do PE and outdoor learning on their designated playdecks, courtyard, ground floor hall or second floor hall.



In just over 1 year, we will have a state-of-the-art primary school!

- 14 classrooms
- 3 specialist teaching rooms including a music studio, science lab and library
- 3 playdecks (Year 1-Year 6)
- 1 courtyard & covered open play area and additional play area next to the classrooms for the Early Years
- 2 large halls
