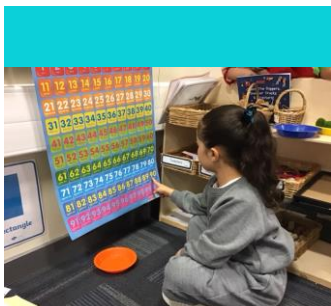
At APSoL this week;
