Seesaw

At APSoL, we are preparing for all eventualities relating to the current unprecedented times. In order for children to access learning from home, we have opted to use Seesaw online platform to initially share home-learning and in the near future, share classwork with you as you cannot at this time, visit the school. The other positive thing about using Seesaw is that teachers can also tailor the activities to meet your child's needs particularly with phonics, fine motor and numbers.

Consent forms have been sent home – those who have returned these will be receiving a unique log in code on Friday 6th November which must not be shared with anyone else in the class. Where parents do not share the same address and the child will be accessing home-learning at different addresses, please notify the school so that the school can send you this safely (please do not use social media to share the code with different family members).

If you haven't already done so, please return your consent form by Monday. If your child has been away from school, please communicate with the school for this to be collected or delivered to you.
