At APSoL this week;

This week we continued with our Autumn/Celebrations topic. We read and familiarised ourselves with 'Pumpkin Soup' by Helen Cooper. The children now know the story very well. They have sequenced the story, acted it out and written 'missing' posters for 'duck'.

In Maths, the children have been learning about circles and triangles. We talked about the properties of both shapes, recreated shapes with our bodies and went on a shape hunt around school. Our discussions also led us to talk about oval shapes, semi circles and equilateral triangles. Next week, our focus will be 'subitising'. Subitising refers to the ability to look at a small group of objects and know the amount without counting.

A provocation for our maths lessons came from looking at the artwork of Wassily Kandinsky. Kandinsky was a famous Russian painter who used shapes in his abstract work.

Outside, the children have been very creative, extending their play in the pumpkin shop and creating vehicles out of planks, blocks and wooden poles.
