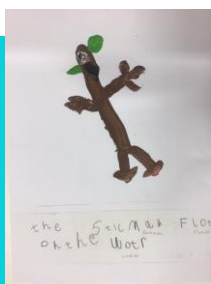

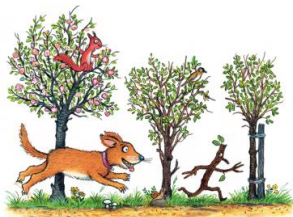
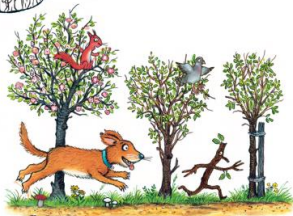
Nesta semana, estivemos a partilhar as nossas tradições de Natal como hábitos natalícios e gastronomia.
