In Maths, we have been investigating how many different shapes we can make from four, five and six blocks. This required the children to think really hard, as each shape had to be different, rather than positioned differently.

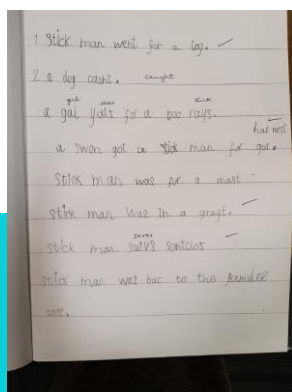
