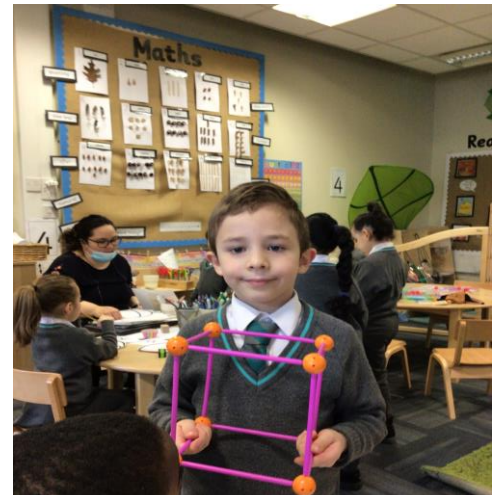
The chicks that came to visit have now gone. We loved looking after them and seeing them grow into chicks.
