Phonics and Literacy

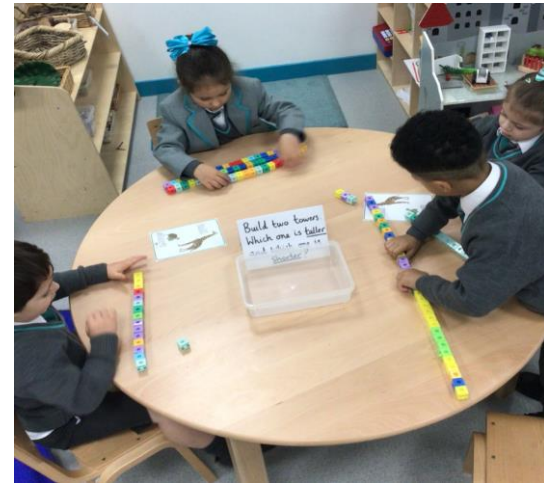
