

Dear families,

A warm welcome back to everyone and our new Reception families.

I am very pleased to inform you of our incredible curriculum provision and all the exciting things taking place this year! There is a slight delay with the building works, even though quite a few surveys took place throughout the summer. The reasons for the delay are explained on the last page, by the Department for Education (DfE), who are responsible for the works at APSOL.

This is what we are all excited about and hopefully, you will share the same enthusiasm!

## **Curriculum enrichment for all year groups:**

Forest schools: Reception and Year 1 will be having forest school sessions which focus on outdoor learning and play. Our forest schools provider is now local, Forest Freedom, which means we will not need to be travelling by coach. The forest schools provider we will be using is already known to the school and is within walking distance. Reception will have their first session next week and year 1 the week after, alternating from then on.

- > <u>Swimming:</u> Year 2 will commence their swimming programme on Thursday 22nd September and have swimming every Thursday at Putney Leisure Centre. The children will be travelling by bus. They will be accompanied by school staff and volunteers and have 3 swimming instructors so that swimming tuition can be personalised to their ability.
- ➤ <u>Music Lessons</u>: Music lessons will be every Tuesday for Reception, Year 1 and Year 2. Our new music teacher from the Wandsworth Music Service is Ms Grace.

## > Sports lessons with a Fitness for Schools Specialist:

All year groups, Reception, Year 1 and Year 2, will be having a PE lesson with a Sports specialist, Mr Regan every Tuesday.

## > Lunch time play times:

Whilst we are awaiting the start of the building works, we are going to have a Sports Play Coach from Fitness for Schools to provide additional physical activities for children during lunchtimes. The children will have independent choice on which activities they access as playtimes also support their creativity and imaginative development.

We are incredibly excited about all of this provision and I am sure, that you as parents are too.

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Update from the DfE Capital Projects Management Team, responsible for all the building works at APSOL, August 2022:

APSoL Permanent School Update - August 2022

Further to the last update in July, the DfE continues to work with the appointed contractor to finalise the detailed design of the scheme for the full refurbishment of the building for the permanent school. We anticipate that this work will conclude by the end of September.

However, the potential risk highlighted in the last update, that the start of works on site may be held-up because of a delay to receipt of planning consent from Wandsworth Council has materialised.

We are still waiting for a determination of the planning application - six weeks after the due date. The contractor has addressed all the queries raised by the council and we are pressing the Council for the decision to be made as soon as possible.

All the works to provide the accommodation required for September 2022 are complete. Depending on when the planning decision is received and whether there is any application for a judicial review, we now anticipate works will start on site by early December and be completed by July 2023.

The DfE will continue to press Wandsworth Council for the urgent determination of the planning application. We will also review the other risks with the Trust on a regular basis. We will provide a further update in December on the revised programme for completion of the works.
