Attendance monitoring:

Our whole school attendance is 91.5% this week which continues to be very low in relation to our expectations — this figure is also affected by persistent lateness by a small number of children. Please support the school to achieve our target of 96%. We need all families to commit to this. We understand that during winter there are several viruses that are more prone to this season, however, we are very concerned about persistent absentees and persistent lateness(all year-round). Implications of arriving late have already been shared with families. Please note that the school has a duty to report concerns. Where your child arrives late after registers are closed they will get an absent mark for the morning period (government requirement). This term, you will be receiving a termly attendance report for your child. Your child's overall attendance will be low if they have arrived regularly late after registers are closed as their morning attendance will be considered as an absence. Parents will be given a set of actions which they will need to show improvement on during the following term. Where there is no notable improvement, the school will have to take further action and involve external agencies.
