A special welcome to our new families in Reception and other year groups. All the children have settled in very well, learning new routines very quickly and showing lots of enthusiasm for learning.



RECEPTION

Reception have been exploring their new classroom as they embark on their new learning adventure at APSoL. YEAR 1

Year 1 have loved immersing themselves in their new topic, dinosaur. The children were excited to become dinosaur detectives; finding out exciting dino facts to share with the class. YEAR 2

SENCO UPDATES

SPEECH & LANGUAGE THERAPY AT APSOL

Some children with speech and language needs,

will have SLT sessions with their NHS speech therapist. However, a significant amount of children with speech difficulties will not qualify for NHS SLT support. Nevertheless, this year we are working closely with London Clinic, Sloane Square and have a private speech therapist to support all our children who need this, attending the school on a fortnightly basis.

Speech & language Therapists can support children with the following:

- Speech fluency and stammering
- Attention and listening
- Play skills
- Understanding and using spoken language
- Recognising and producing speech sounds
- Using other ways of communicating, eg using signing and symbols
- Eating and drinking

The school will be contacting you directly if your child has been referred to our SLT for additional support. It is important for us that your child receives early intervention/support in order for them to achieve their potential at school.



ELSA EMOTIONAL LITERACY THERAPIST

At APSOL we value the individual needs of each child and aim to support each child so that they can achieve their potential.

One of our teaching team members will be doing ELSA training to become an ELSA teacher.

ELSA is aimed to support children with social and emotional needs. The ELSA teacher will be trained and supervised by Educational Psychologists.

What areas does an ELSA help with?

- Loss and bereavement
- Emotional Literacy
- Self-esteem
- Social Skills
- Friendship issues
- Relationships
- Managing strong feelings
- Anxiety and worries
- Bullying
- Conflict
- Emotional Regulation
- Growth Mindset
- Social and therapeutic stories
- Problem solving

We are very pleased to be able to offer this support to our children at school and looking forward to the sessions starting. We will contact parents directly, if their child has been referred to ELSA?
