
## Results from our Parent Survey March 2025








46/47 parents who completed the survey, are happy with the quality of education. Apsol leadership are open to parents/carers communicating any concerns directly with the school.

When started she was not confident without parents, every day was a challange to let her in the school and she did not speak any english. Today she praticly lives in the school, always is happy to attend and she acts very independent.




46/47 parents who completed the survey, said their child is happy and safe at school. Where a child expresses otherwise, we encourage the parents to communicate directly with the school.








The school will endeavour to improve all aspects of communication.





The school has high expectations for all children. This is regularly monitored by our School Improvement Advisor, Wandsworth Link Inspector and through external moderation.






The school offers a wide-range of after school clubs and subsidizes some places to make these available to all children. Reception children have after school care. In the summer term we increase the provision for Reception children given age and ratios needed for this age group.





In comparison to other local state schools, the school has a very thorough enrichment program. Parents can share their suggestions about enrichment provision in the additional comments or by speaking to the team. We are always seeking this aspect of school life as its of such benefit for the children.



## What can we better?

• More updates about child's individual progress. Provision of assessments.

Teachers meet with parents in the Autumn term and in the Spring term. If children have Special Educational Needs, the SENCO will also meet with parents. Parents who have specific concerns or queries, can speak to the teachers at drop off, pick up or request a meeting. The school has communicated this and encouraged this from the start of your child's education at APSOI. The school provides a school report for all children at the end of the year. Children's assessments are kept in their exercise books. You can view these at the various opportunities we provide for parents to come in for assemblies and see books. You can also ask for a meeting should you need this information for private tutoring.

• Children to be exposed to more Portuguese, through other subjects.

Great idea! School leadership and Camões Language teachers are currently exploring which subjects lend themselves better to CLIL (Content and Language Integrated Learning). We will be communicating more on this at a future date.
